The Chile Pepper Story

The Stats

What do 500 lbs of taco meat, 500 lbs of sandwich meat, 1000 pounds of fruit, 100 gallons of salsa, 150 lbs of chips and 5,000 runners have in common? They will all collide on October 5th at The Chile Pepper Cross Country Festival. This much anticipated sporting festival, in its 3rd decade, is one of those annual events that give Northwest Arkansas its unique charm. The Chile Pepper Cross Country Festival Open 10K amateur race is this year's RRCA (Road Runners Club of America) Arkansas State Cross Country Championships.

John McDonnell, retired University of Arkansas Coach and Chile Pepper Board Member, "This is one of the country's best events for young people to experience national caliber competition on a great course and see the best of the best. Northwest Arkansas has worked hard to develop and host one of our nation's finest running festivals. It gives amateur runners the chance to race on one of the best courses, and it is a great day for spectators of all ages."

This one-day event will attract 5,000 runners comprised of 80 colleges, 120 high schools and more than 750 amateur runners from across the nation to the Northwest Arkansas area. Equally impressive is that there will be more than 5,000 spectators, many of whom are parents and grandparents of the college and high school runners.

The History

By now, most people have heard of the unique history that filled a community need. In 1988, Joe Fennel, Randy Rhine and Kelly O'Meara, the Fayetteville High School cross-country coach, were out running. Kelly mentioned that his cross-country budget was \$100.00. Joe and Randy created the Chile Pepper Running Club and from there, the Chile Pepper Run. It was originally held in May and consisted of the 10K open cross-country run only. The festival was created in 1992 to bring together three Northwest Arkansas cross-country races under one event which has blossomed into a premier running event in America. The Festival united the Chile Pepper Run; the Arkansas Invitational, the annual Men's and Women's Razorback home meet; and the Fayetteville High School's Purple Dog Invitational. This created the platform and critical mass for exponential growth that literally fed on itself.

"Joe Fennel, festival founder, deserves "godpepper status" for nurturing the event from its seeds of infancy to the giant pepper it is now. However, it is larger than any one person now, and constituents of the community keep growing the event each year with a shared vision to benefit our next generation of runners" said Jay Lewis, Race Director.

The Event Today

Now the Chile Pepper hosts approximately 10,000 people each year and has a distinct positive economic impact not only to the running community but Northwest Arkansas at large. Dozens of teams and hundreds of people stay in hotels, go to restaurants, buy gas, and create a home grown stimulus for the area.

It takes a lot of commitment on the part of hundreds of volunteers, thousands of participants and the 10 member Chile Pepper Board who organizes this Festival. It requires money and resources to manage an event of this scale. "In a recovering economy for many, it must be pointed out that most existing sponsors maintained their level of support and several new sponsors added their resources to continue to grow this nationally recognized event and expand support for our local athletes" said Lewis.

A consistent belief shared among the Chile Pepper Board is that Running is a sport that can last a lifetime, and an organized start can help kids learn to train right and stick with it. Perhaps Chile Pepper Board Member Reuben Reina sums it up best, "I got involved with the Chile Pepper Race to give back to the sport that has given me so much in life, and to help the next local kid to have the opportunity to reach his or her dreams in the sport."

How the Schools Help

"2012 was a record setting year for donations to the 6 area high schools and 2013 will match it. The Chile Pepper Race Committee will donate \$6,000 each to the seven area high schools and welcome Siloam Springs aboard this year. It is not a free ride. Each school provides volunteers to help the event with duties such as: course set up/tear down, food service, water stations, merchandise sales, trash pickup, registration, etc... They know without their teamwork and involvement, the gun would never go off. Even more amazing are the dozens of unsung "citizen" volunteers come out every year to perform necessary tasks to make the event run smoothly and safely" said David Swain, President of the Chile Pepper Board.

Saturday, October 5th is when all the activities take place. The Open 10K will begin at 7:30am and the Open 5K at 9:00am. The collegiate men's race is next followed by the collegiate women's race. Following the collegiate races, 6 boys and girls senior and junior high school races will be held.

Food and Fun Stuff

The festival has some other unique features tied to its roots and the NWA area. Jose's and Jose's Southwest Grill Mexican Restaurants (with help from Ben E. Keith and Twin City Produce) feed all runners for free who participate in the race and spectators for \$5. The festival continues the tradition of a 'running Chile pepper' themed t-shirt that sells out each year. Back this year is a VIP tent that provides perks such as on course parking, valet bag storage, extra portapotties, no registration or food lines and massage therapists. Unique awards including locally custom-designed pottery plates maintain the character of the Chile Pepper along with a merchandise tent that has Chile peppers available to wear from head to toe. Continued is the elite-level boy's and girl's high school races having the 'traveling' cups engraved with the school name of the winners of the team competition.





8K Men's Collegiate Race




